1. WELCOME

1.1 Apologies

Apologies were received from Sandy Graham.

1.2 Minutes confirmation

Gary noted his appreciation for Bryan stepping in at the last meeting.

2. HON RACHEL BROOKING MP

Rachel Brooking, MP for Dunedin, and Glen Bennett MP, Labour spokesperson for Economic Development and associate for Energy, joined the Forum as part of its ongoing initiative to build relationships with Otago-based and Otago-representative Members of Parliament.

Ms Brooking invited Forum members to think about the policy direction they'd like to see and the messages they want to be sending. Discussion focussed on the Fast Track Approvals Bill, with members citing much uncertainty about its implications for their districts and the role of councils.

The New Dunedin Hospital was also raised, with those present expressing concern about potential cuts signalled by Central Government.

3. NEW DUNEDIN HOSPITAL

Blake Lepper, Head of Infrastructure Delivery, Health New Zealand – Te Whatu Ora, joined the Forum to update members on the New Dunedin Hospital project.

Mr Lepper outlined his experience and personal connections to the Otago region. He noted that the Dunedin hospital is an acute focus for everyone and that he was limited at this point as to how much he could say on it. Health NZ received additional funding for the hospital earlier in 2024, but a shortfall remains. They were working hard to try and close the gaps and to get a contract on the table that could be recommended to government and would deliver a hospital that was fit for purpose.

Mr Lepper noted that more information would be made available to the public shortly as to which direction that was heading, and once that was done, he was happy to come back to the Forum and take them through it step by step.

4. LOCAL WATER DONE WELL WORKING GROUP

5. ENGAGEMENT WITH MINISTERS, INCLUDING UPCOMING REGIONAL SUMMIT

Members discussed options for engagement with Ministers and Members of Parliament as a Forum. Minister Shane Jones will be in Dunedin for a Regional Economic Development Summit on October 4. It was suggested that Mark Patterson MP be invited to the next Mayoral Forum or dinner.

Mayor Kircher noted that the Canterbury Mayoral Forum is planning to travel to Wellington early in 2025 for a series of Ministerial meetings at Parliament, and suggested that the Otago Mayoral Forum may wish to pursue a similar event. It was **agreed** that the Chair and secretariat would look into options, noting that Forum members would need to be cohesive in their messaging and to pull key messages together in advance of any meeting.

6. REGIONAL DEALS: FRAMEWORK ANNOUNCEMENT

In the light of the newly-released Regional Deals Strategic Framework, the Forum considered implications for Otago as summarized in an agenda paper. Mayor Lewers noted that the Framework allowed for sub-regional deals and said that Queenstown Lakes was actively looking at options that might leverage their

existing Regional Growth Partnership arrangements.

7. GENERAL BUSINESS AND WRAP UP

- Update on regional collaboration priorities: Otago's new Regional Waste Advisor, Anna Robinson, has now started in her role. The role is direct outcome of the 2019-2022 Forum's prioritisation of waste and recycling collaboration. Ms Robinson is making an effort to get around the region as a priority.
- Agenda items for the next Regional Leadership Group hui: none identified.
- General business:
 - Winterstellar Charitable Trust briefing note. Forum members noted a written update received from Brian Boyle, who had been a previous visitor to the Forum speaking about dark sky initiatives.
 - Matters arising from the LGNZ conference and AGM. Mayor Tim Cadogan reported that these had gone well. There had been good feedback about combining the community board conference with that traditionally targeting councillors and mayors.
 - Unitary councils. Members acknowledged proposals looking into unitary councils, notably at Dunedin City Council and in the Southland region. Mayor Radich clarified that the DCC initiative is at the point of identifying possible arrangements for looking at the matter, and no detailed work is underway.
 - Waitangi Day / Te Ropū Taiao funding and attendance. Mayor Lewers advised that planning for 2025 Waitangi Day commemorations in Queenstown Lakes is underway. Councils will be asked to signal who will be attending, and QLDC is likely to request a small financial contribution from other councils. An application was also in preparation seeking funding from the Ministry for Culture and Heritage.
 - DIA restructure. Mayor Lewers reported that DIA is undertaking a restructure, affecting the Local Government branch and partnership director roles. LGNZ has written to the department on the matter. It was **agreed** that the Forum would write to DIA advocating for strong policy and engagement on local government matters.
